Christian,

Our office, including all staff members and myself, feel it is in everyone's best interest to dissolve a working relationship with you considering the events that have taken place the past few weeks. It has become an uncomfortable situation as we cannot trust the information you relay to us on protocols, procedures, and post procedure care. I am not sure you understand the gravity of the situation.

Despite my discussing Dr Mulholland's treatment recommendations I learned from the prior conference (50 mj) with you, under your instruction, we treated Sue Mardock's entire face at 62 mj with very firm pressure. No adjustments were made for the bony areas around her eyes or for her forehead. Every time we questioned the pressure, you told us to press even harder. This was the same instruction you gave us for Melissia Webb's neck. Both women are extensively scarred. Further, you told both patients that they only needed one application of polysporin, coconut oil and no follow up with the physician; and they would be healed in 5-7 days. Again, I tried to comment that I was not comfortable with that post procedure care, and you insisted. In fact, Sue needed Valtrex, Doxycyclin, Fluconazole, Bactroban, Biafine, Growth Factors, Treatment Ceramide, etc, in addition to wearing silicone scar sheeting overnight for the past few weeks and at 5 weeks post procedure the patient is disfigured. I have seen her 9 times for followup. Melissia also has scarred and we begin her repair treatments tomorrow. Both women are filing formal complaints against you and the company. There may be litigation. I believe that you acted negligent and reckless and put my reputation and practice in jeopardy.

I discussed my feelings with Brian Lody, and told him that I did purchase the equipment because I believe in the technology, but would need another representative to work with. I do plan on completing my luminary obligations, but do not feel that professionally I can work with you.
